4. God told Aaron to meet Moses (*at Pharaoh's palace, in the desert, by the Red Sea*).

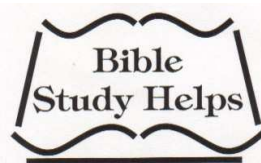
