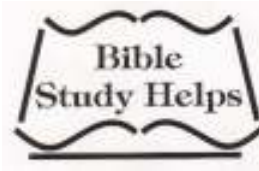
DAY 7 — Numbers 20:9-13; Ephesians 5:20
