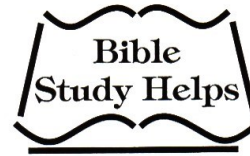
DAY 6 – Deuteronomy 31:14, 15, 23; 34:1, 4, 5

Moses Goes to Heaven

DAY 1 – Numbers 26:1-2, 51, 62

God was about to fulfill his promise to the Israelites. They had been waiting for this for 40 years. **Cross out (X)** the wrong word(s) in each parenthesis.
