## DAY 5 – Joshua 3:5-17

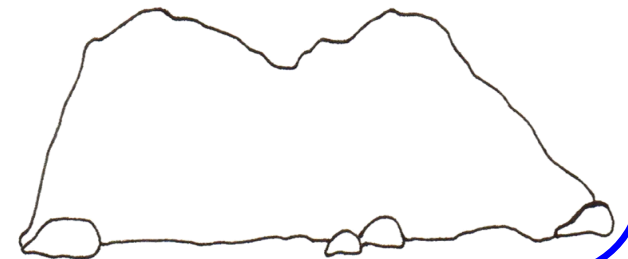

3. **Print** on the rock a promise God has kept for you.

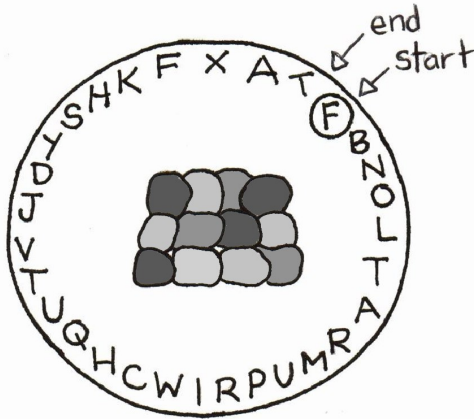


## DAY 7 – Joshua 4:15-24

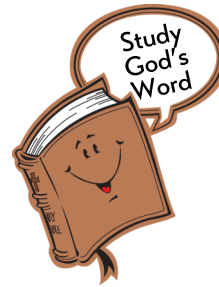

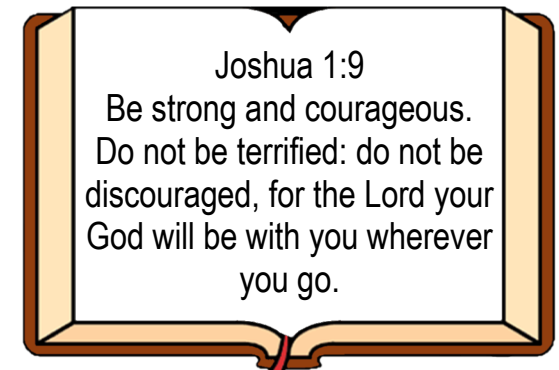
