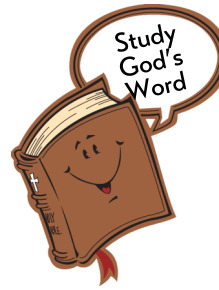
## DAY 5 – Judges 6:17-23

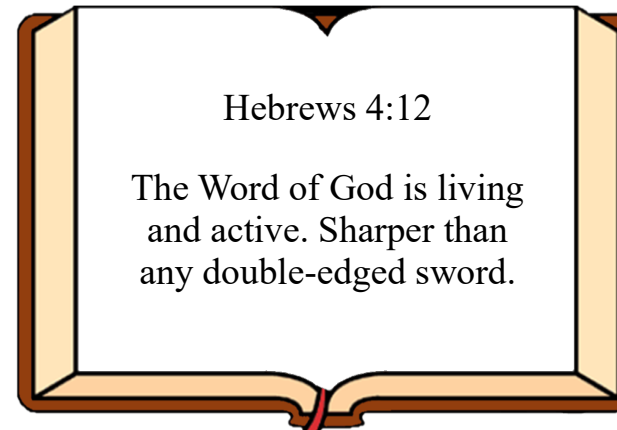
