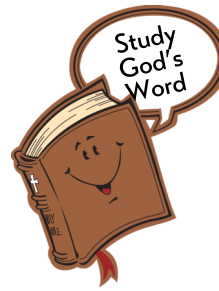

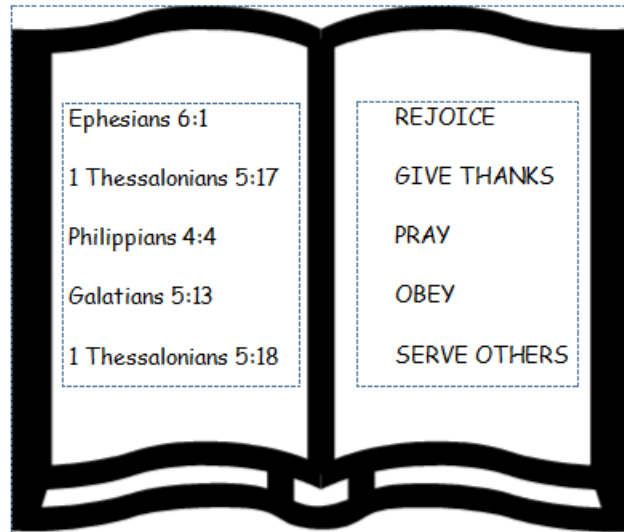

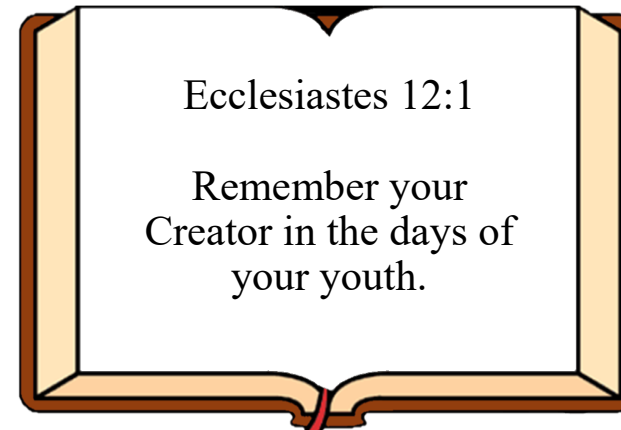


DAY 7 – Special Activity
