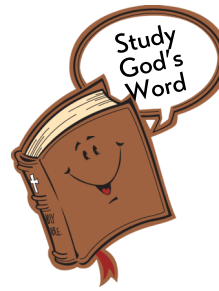

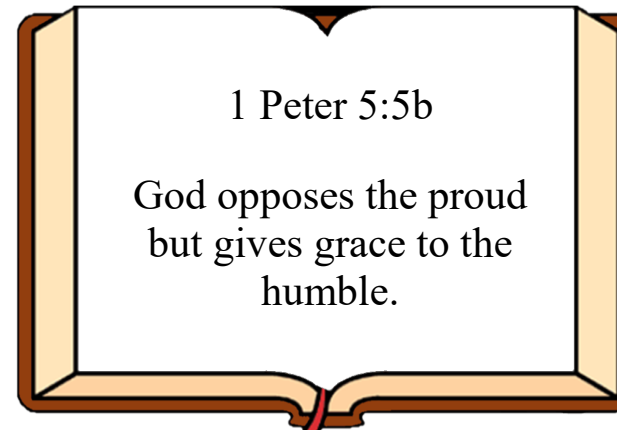
When Solomon's kingdom became strong, Giant Pride conquered Solomon.
