Did you know, God's plan of Salvation can be explained with **6 simple colors!**

## HOW DO YOU Respond?

The Bible tells us that if we want to be saved from the penalty of our sin and go to heaven, we must believe that the answer to all of the summary questions are "YES" and "TRUE". If you believe these things to be true and want to accept God's loving gift, you can say a prayer like the one below to ask Jesus to be your Savior from sin.

Dear God,  
I know that I have sinned and done bad things.  
I know that I can never be good enough by myself to get to Heaven.

But I believe that Jesus, God's Son, died on the cross to pay the price for ALL my sin and then came back to life!

So right now, I believe in Jesus,  
and take Him as my **ONLY** way to Heaven.

Thank you God, for saving me,  
and please help me to live for YOU each day.

In Jesus' Name, Amen

The Lord, and all His angels are rejoicing just for you!

**REMINDS US OF** Jesus' blood when he died to pay for our sin



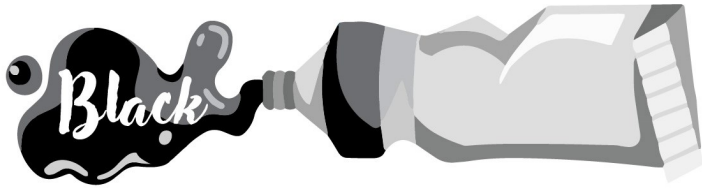
**STANDS FOR OUR** faith in Jesus as our Savior

REPRESENTS  
THAT ALL  
PEOPLE SIN

The Bible says that sin is anything you “think, say or do” that breaks God’s Law. Sin is when you disobey God.

**Romans 3:23** tells us:

*“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”*

Just like when you disobey your parents, when you disobey God there is a punishment. This is because God is perfect (Holy) and fair (Just). He can not accept sin and sin requires a punishment. The Bible describes the punishment for disobeying God in **Romans 6:23**

*“For the wages of sin is death. . .”*

Really bad news for all of us, but God has a loving plan to save us as we will talk about in the next few colors.

Now we will talk about the final result of accepting God’s loving gift of salvation. This is an amazing part of the gift that we get to look forward to our entire lives!

**John 14:2** Jesus tells us:

*“In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?”*

Jesus is telling us that He is preparing a place in Heaven for everyone who accepts His gift of salvation. Jesus continues to tell us in **John 14:3**

*“And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.”*

So Jesus will take everyone who accepts His gift of salvation to Heaven where we will live forever with Him.

**GROW IN FAITH AND OBEDIENCE TO GOD**

We talked about being forgiven as soon as we accept God's gift of salvation. Now let's talk how accepting God's loving gift changes you.

After we accept God's gift we naturally want to say "thank you" for God's great gift. We learn how we should respond to God in **2 Peter 3:18**:

***"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."***

God wants to have a relationship with us. God wants us to learn more about Him, obey Him and to love Him more just like He loves us.

Christians want to grow closer to God because of the great and loving gift God has given us. Growing closer to God will give us peace and joy in our lives.

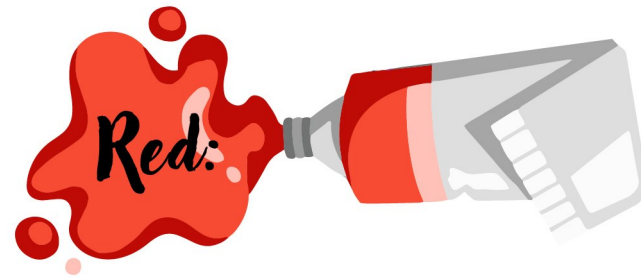

**REMINDS US OF JESUS' BLOOD WHEN HE DIED TO PAY FOR OUR SIN**

Earlier we talked about how justice demands a punishment for our sin, but God is also perfectly Loving.

God knows that you can not save yourself so God loved us so much that He sent His only Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay for our sins. Jesus lived a perfect life and then took our punishment so that all our sins may be forgiven (cleansed).

**1 John 1:7 says it this way:**

***"the blood of Jesus, His Son cleanses us from all sin"***

Jesus willingly died on a cross for our sins so that we may be forgiven. That is a great and loving God!

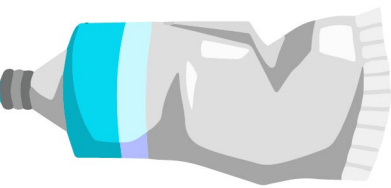

STANDS FOR OUR FAITH IN JESUS AS OUR SAVIOR

We talked about how God is loving and sent His Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay for our sins. That is the greatest gift we can ever receive because along with forgiveness comes eternal life with Him in Heaven.

There is one thing that you need to do, accept God's gift by faith. The Bible says in **Ephesians 2:8-9**:

***"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast."***

If you don't accept God's gift of forgiveness through faith in Jesus it is like leaving the best Christmas gift ever under the tree unopened forever - and it will do you no good. Accepting the gift is as easy as A-B-C

- A - Admit you sin
- B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son and He died for your sins
- C - Choose Jesus as your only Savior from sin

MEANS YOU ARE FORGIVEN WHEN YOU TRUST IN JESUS

We have talked about how you accept God's loving gift by faith. This color and the following two, we will talk more about the gift God has given us.

The first thing that happens as soon as you accept God's gift of salvation is that you are forgiven of every sin. You are completely cleansed from all sin as it says in **Isaiah 1:18**

***"Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be like wool."***

Just like you could do nothing to save yourself, if you accept God's gift of forgiveness you can do nothing to lose your forgiveness since it is all based on Jesus' payment of our sin.

Your sins are washed clean and you are forever forgiven by God.
