Dig Deeper: Just think the lord and king over everything in this world wants you to be part of His family. All you need to be part of His family is accept His free gift.

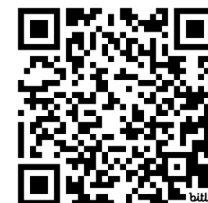
